

## Saffire Grill: 18" & 19" Old Elevator/Rack & Heat Deflector vs New Models

Here is the old triangular Cooking Grid Elevator as typically used. (Without the Cooking Grid)  
You can also see the original Ceramic Heat Deflector with the three flanges. (Discontinued)



Here the triangle is placed down to hold the new, 2-piece Heat Deflector or Pizza Stone



The cooking grid sits on top of the supports like this



**The new Multi-Rack may also be purchased.** (19" & 23" models)  
(Also recommended for use with the new Crucible Firebox. It's larger size works better.)

It has four supports instead of three. Here it is with one half of the new Heat Deflector in place. It allows you to use the Heat Deflector whether the Cooking Grid is in the top or bottom position.



**Attention:** one possible issue with the Multi-Rack in an older grill...  
The support legs are further out so the grill opening **must be close to 19" diameter**.  
Some older grills (SG18 & SG19 were closer to 18 3/4" making it difficult to get the Multi-rack in and out of the grill. (Solution below)  
**Note:** Most of the original **SG22** grills (2009-2010) are too small for the Multi-Rack

#### Simple Fix

There is a small lip of ceramic around the top which may be sanded down fairly easily.  
We found it easy to use a sanding disc or file by hand.  
You may also use an angle grinder/mini-grinder if desired. (More dust)  
Just sand off about 1/8" at the 12, 6, 3 and 9 o'clock positions as shown below in red.
